To our Russian mission partners,

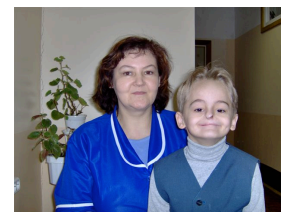

They are in Moscow right now - Sergey is having some tests in the hospital which will help expedite the Dr.'s decision in Germany. His mother is applying for visas to get to Finland. Please pray for these visas to become a reality and then pray that they will be successful in getting the European visas in Finland. This will be Sergey's final chance.
